# Explaining the Jargon

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## What is a **Programme**?

Graduate Diploma  
in Construction Project Management  
(GDCPM)

## What is a **Course**?

- Some institutions refer to courses as 'papers'
- The courses make up your programme
- A course has a 4-letter code followed by a 4-letter number  
e.g. CONS5101 (Technology 1)

# PGDCM Programme Overview

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Two **compulsory**  
courses:

- CONS6100 Project Management Principles
- CONS7200 Project Management Practice

Six **elective** courses:

Must include at least four at Level 7

# PGDCM Pattern of Delivery

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**CONS6100, CONS7200,  
other Level 7 courses:**

Classes delivered in two  
'blocks', each of two full days

**Other Level 6 courses:**

- Each course runs for eight weeks
- Classes twice a week (4-hour sessions)

# PGDCM Study Workload

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Full-time study on the **post graduate diploma** programme is like a full-time job



Two compulsory courses and all level 7 courses are delivered in two 2-day blocks (total 32 hrs class time, meaning approximately 118 hrs of individual study per course)

Other Level 6 courses are delivered over seven weeks (half a semester) with two classes per week (total 56 hrs class time, and 94 hrs of individual study per course)



Don't try to study full-time and work full-time

## Short login

First five letters of your surname, first initial, 2-digit number

e.g. Jo Bloggs → bloggj99

*Use this login to access: campus Wi-Fi; Student Self Service*



## Long login (your Unitec student email address):

Your short login + **@myunitec.ac.nz**

e.g. Jo Bloggs → bloggj99@myunitec.ac.nz

*Use this login to access: My Portal; Moodle; SEAtS*



## Password

For both logins,

the default password is your date of birth in this format: **DDMMYYYY**







Unitec students can get Microsoft Office 365 for free, which includes the use of useful programmes such as Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, Excel and OneNote.





# Finding Rooms on Campus

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
Usually, the room number is located on the architrave above the room's door
