Mauri Oho / Emerging “You have begun to explore opportunities to practise and develop this aspect of teaching competency but have not yet provided evidence that you are consistently demonstrating it.”	The artefacts give evidence of improving your teaching strategies for Pacific learners. Example artefacts: <i>Lesson outline, photos, audio, videos, teaching materials, peer observation, student feedback.</i>	Clear description of how you feel after making improvements to your teaching of Pacific learners.
Mauri Tū / Demonstrating “You consistently demonstrate this aspect of teaching competency and actively look for opportunities for further growth.”	As above (for Emerging), AND Sufficient artefacts, developed over time, give evidence of improving the teaching of Pacific learners. Artefacts indicate evidence of a range of learning and teaching approaches that best suits Pacific learners. Example artefacts: <i>Lesson outline with Photos, audio, videos, teaching materials, peer observation, student feedback, and evidence of working with Pacific learners over time.</i>	As above (for Emerging), AND Include reference to: a) teaching practices and pedagogies, models and teaching approaches b) at least two examples of evidence of improvement in your practice with regards to teaching of Pacific learners.
Mauri Ora / Modelling “You are considered a role model for this aspect of teaching competency and support others to develop in this area.”	As above (for Demonstrating), AND Sufficient artefacts, developed over time, give evidence of learning experiences with Pacific learners. Artefacts indicate recognition of your excellent practice and your support for other teachers over time. Additional example artefacts: <i>Feedback from peers, line managers and students.</i>	As above (for Demonstrating), AND Provide a clear description of how you share your expertise, or support others to develop in this area.
